**Lorrie Garrison** met her husband, **Daryl**, at the **Rochester** chapter of **Parents Without Partners**

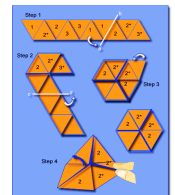
### Did You Know? (Cont'd)

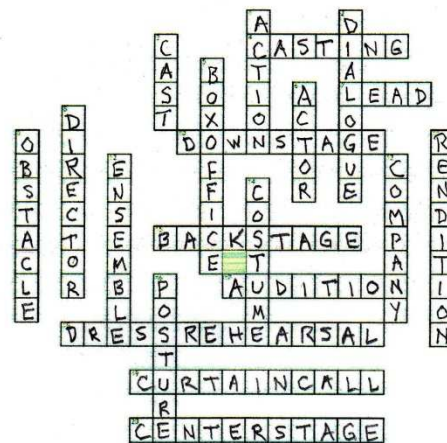
