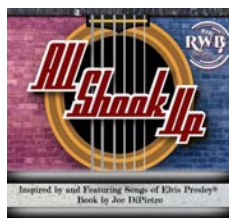

Rob Grodin took adult tap classes for 2 years when his daughter was in high school, and he was in a recital too.

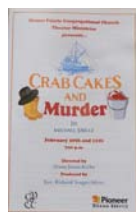
Mary Jo Gunter worked with special needs people as a para-pro for 17 years.

**TO PREPARE:**

- 1). **Murder Mystery**, be ready to do a three to four sentence reading. You don't even have to memorize it! I will put people together to read from a different murder mystery script.
- 2). **YAGMCB**, prepare a 16 measure snippet of a song, to be performed acapella. The song you prepare does not have to be from YAGMCB. You will be taught a song from YAGMCB and will read for the character you would like. We will be doing the revised edition.

**SHOW AUDITION GOALS:**

The **Murder Mystery** will need up to 10 performers and **YAGMCB** has 6 main characters, but other Peanuts characters can be added (such as Peppermint Patty, Marcie, Violet, Franklin, Pig Pen etc.)
