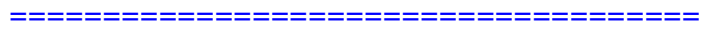

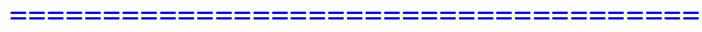
### Our HOH Picnic!

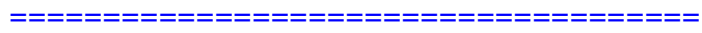

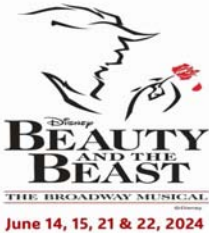

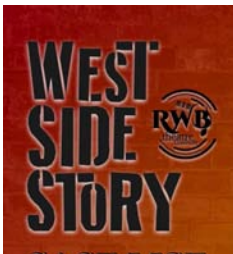
